Michael Kelley Responds to Davis' Lack of Transparency

"The citizens of Kentucky deserve transparency and full disclosure from our elected officials.

Representative Geoff Davis refuses to disclose the client list of his family-owned firm, even when news articles credibly suggest that his family business is serving "defense contractors and financial-sector companies overseen by Davis as a member of the House Armed Services Committee and the House Financial Services Committee, from General Dynamics, Lockheed Martin and Raytheon to Freddie Mac, AIG and JPMorgan Chase."

This is just more evidence of Representative Davis' honesty deficit. First, Davis expects the voters in northern Kentucky to believe that the millions of dollars pouring into his campaign from the financial sector do not influence his votes on the House Financial Services Committee, and now Davis won't tell us who is pouring money into his family's consulting firm.

Kentucky deserves honest representation in Washington, and Geoff Davis will not provide it. I am a small-money candidate. I have not taken any special-interest money. On Election Day we have a clear choice. We can vote for Davis and get more of the same pay-to-play Washington-insider games, or we can vote for change."
